.... Attempted to make sense of future uncertainties

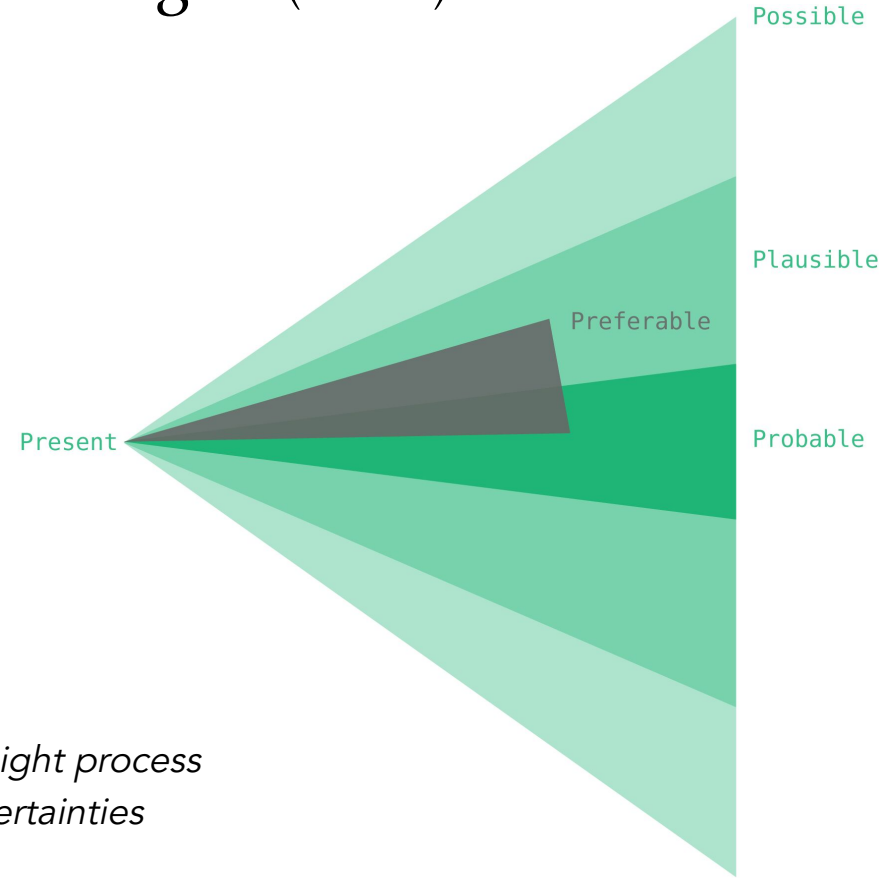


.... Deepened your sense of empathy for a vulnerable group

Futures thinking is a general term for a design process that explores future uncertainties.

Strategic foresight is one method that systematically uses present data to create multiple future scenarios** from which we can make decisions today.

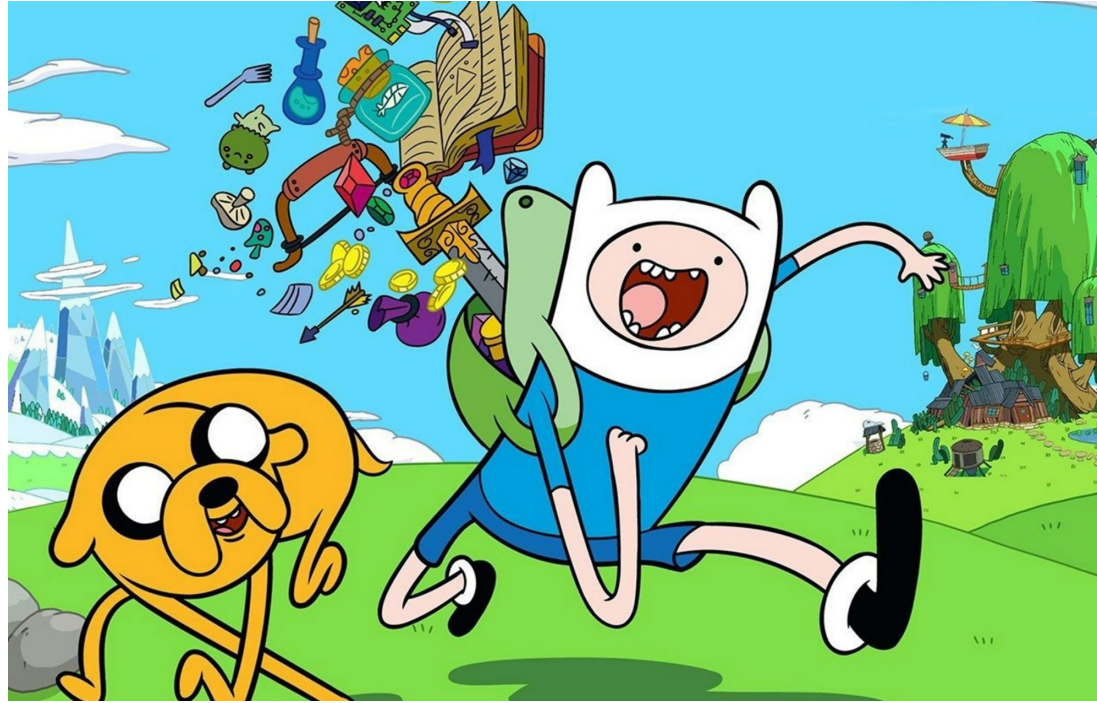
Current Positions:

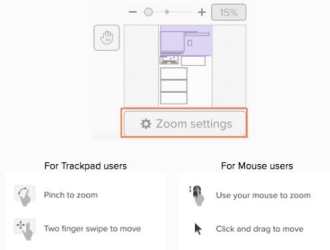

Types of Fear

1. Physiological fear
Fear of physical harm

2. Safety Fear
Fear that makes you feel insecure

3. Ego death/esteem fear
Fear that causes a lack of confidence

4. Belonging Fear
Fear that makes you feel lonely / alienated

5. Loss of Autonomy
Fear that causes a loss of your sense of being /
cannot be resolved by yourself
