

DEMYSTIFICATION - I

- ☐ How do we even recognize the domain called Policy?
- How does it differ from politics?
- Is policy-making neutral above all the tumult and the fray?
- How does policy interact with law?
- How does one define its boundaries? Should one?

DEMYSTIFICATION - II

- ☐ How do we even recognize the domain called Policy?
- Is it rational, quantifiable, scientific? Can & should it be?
- Are policy discourses normatively indeterminate?



DEMYSTIFICATION - III

- ☐ The Process of Policy-Making
- Does it matter who frames policy questions who has a say and who doesn't?
- And are there 'good' and 'bad' policy questions?
- How does one strike a balance between <u>larger</u> norms and <u>local concerns</u>?



DEMYSTIFICATION - IV

- Should abstract <u>Universal Goals</u> even determine Policy at the cost of non-neutral <u>Local Factors</u>?
- Or should policy-making be sanitized to avoid myriad surrounding non-neutral contestations – the messy real life?

OF EXPERTS - I

- ☐ Policy-Making & the Hegemony of Expertise
- What is the role of Knowledge?
- Where does it come from? Why do we trust it?
- Who is served by 'Expertise' & who isn't?
- Which voices are elevated and which subdued?



OF EXPERTS - II

- ☐ Policy-Making & the Hegemony of Expertise
- Identifying stakeholders, constituents, allies, opponents, affectees— Multiplicity of Perspectives
- The Technocratic vs. The Political
- What do we try and sustain through Policies (institutions, citizens, nation states, ideologies, economic systems, something else ...)?

OF EXPERTS - III

- Are 'Expert' claims about <u>unintelligibility of</u> <u>solutions</u> to non-experts credible?
- Is '<u>Expertise</u>' a false necessity; a way to avoid recognition of <u>multiple competing concerns</u>?
- Is it <u>a cunning justification</u> for a particular policy choice from amongst many possibilities?



OF EXPERTS - IV

- Are laws essentially <u>Background Rules to justify</u> certain entrenched economic & political choices?
- Do laws perpetuate an <u>uneven field of</u> <u>negotiation</u> while pretending to be <u>neutral</u>?
- Can law become <u>an escape for avoiding</u> <u>contentious economic & political questions</u>?



OF EXPERTS - V

- How and when does 'Expertise' <u>obfuscate</u> <u>dynamic situations & genuine controversies</u>?
- How is 'Policy-Thinking' impeded by parochial imperatives (ideological, turf-management, strategic, political ...)
- How and when do 'Expert' discourses become open to manipulation?
